

**RAILROAD EQUIPMENT ACCIDENT/INCIDENT
REPORTING THRESHOLD**

Collisions, derailments, fires, explosions, acts of God, or other events involving the operation of railroad on-track equipment (standing or moving) and causing reportable damages greater than the reporting threshold for the year in which the accident/incident occurred must be reported using Form FRA F 6180.54. The following table shows the reporting threshold.
