### Close Call Confidential Reporting System (Updated May, 2008)

Alaska Railroad will be the third company in the Close Call Confidential Reporting System Program pilot activity. At the current rate of implementation, it's anticipated Alaska Railroad will "go live" before the end of 2008. As of 31 March 2008, close call reports began to be accepted from the Canadian Pacific Railroad's Chicago Service Unit, the second of three pilot sites for the Close Call Confidential Reporting System, Union Pacific's North Platt Service Center being the first site.
